Maryland groups join national affordable health care push

Maryland health care advocates will join a \$40 million national campaign Tuesday to lobby for affordable health care for all.

Health Care for America Now, a national health care advocacy group, will launch the campaign in 52 cities. Progressive Maryland, a Silver Spring-based nonprofit advocacy group, will kick off the campaign in Annapolis. The group will be joined by local representatives from ACORN, the United Food & Commercial Workers Union and the Maryland Citizens' Health Initiative.

The groups will ask lawmakers to sign a statement of principles to push for affordable and quality health care access in Maryland.

Health Care for America Now plans to spend the money to promote health care access over the next year in print, television, radio and online advertisements.
