Mock Funeral Held To Support Healthcare Reform

ROCKVILLE, Md. (AP) — Health care reform advocates held a mock funeral procession in Montgomery County as part of a day of protests nationwide.

Tuesday's protest by about 60 people was sponsored by the liberal advocacy group MoveOn.org, which supports a public option in health care reform legislation; the group's Web site said 99 events around the country were planned.

In Maryland, protest-goers drove a hearse followed by several cars with signs like "46 Million Americans: No Health Insurance."

They held a rally around a casket they put at the entrance of a former of United Health care building. The company recently moved and said in a statement it supports "sustainable health care reform."
