Mock Funeral to Support Health Care Set in Rockville

Healthcare reform advocates plan to hold a mock funeral procession in Montgomery County as part of a day of protests nationwide.

The protests Tuesday are sponsored by the liberal advocacy group MoveOn.org; the group's Web site says 99 events are planned.

In Maryland, they plan to drive a hearse through downtown Rockville and place a casket at the door of the office of United Health care Insurance Company. They say United is a member of a national organization representing health insurance companies that has spent millions opposing healthcare reform.

The group supports a public option in healthcare reform legislation. The procession is to begin at 11 a.m.
