<p><b>About the Progressive Maryland Education Fund</b> PMEF is a non-profit, non-partisan organization that monitors and reports on the voting records of state lawmakers and public policy issues.</p>	<p><b>Legislative Scorecard</b> This Scorecard is one of many tools used by PMEF to protect the rights of working families. The 2007 scorecard features voting records on key issues. The two highest-priority votes, indicated in bold at the top of the scorecard, are double-weighted, while the other six votes are single-weighted. The leadership score accounts for 20 points of the lawmaker's final score.</p>	<p><b>Leadership Scores</b> This category scores a lawmaker on the bulk of the General Assembly's work that happens behind the scenes and is crucial to the legislative process: whether a lawmaker works with progressive advocates to advance working-family legislation, lobbies colleagues in favor of these bills, speaks publicly in favor of them, etc.</p>
